<b>Project Criteria</b>	<b>Resident ATL:</b> 12% <b>Resident BTL:</b> 12% <b>Non-Resident ATL:</b> 10% <b>Non-Resident BTL:</b> 10% <b>Minimum Spend:</b> \$75K <b>Project Cap:</b> None <b>Compensation Cap:</b> \$50K
