<b>Incentive</b>	<b>35-37% Rebate</b>
<b>Project Criteria</b>	<b>Resident ATL:</b> 35-37% <b>Resident BTL:</b> 35-37% <b>Minimum Spend:</b> \$25K (in-state); \$50K (total budget) <b>Project Cap:</b> None <b>Compensation Cap:</b> None
<b>Qualified Spend</b>	35% of qualified expenditures. Qualified expenditures include taxable transactions conducted in Oklahoma for a qualified production. <b>Bonus:</b> 2% added to total rebate of qualifying expenditures when OK music/recording is utilized in production.
<b>Program Guidelines</b>	<b>Annual Cap:</b> \$8M <b>Sunset Date:</b> June 30, 2027 <b>Screen Credit:</b> Yes <b>CPA Audit:</b> Yes
<b>Additional Considerations</b>	<b>Loan-out Registration:</b> Yes Non-resident ATL can qualify if paid through a loan-out registered with the Oklahoma Secretary of State. Non-resident BTL can qualify for salaries paid to an individual registered as an Oklahoma Expatriate by the Oklahoma Film + Music Office. The company must provide proof of complete financing prior to commencement of principal photography. This incentive program is administered on a first-come, first- served basis.
