Qualified Spend	15-35% of qualified expenditures. Qualified expenditures include preproduction, production, and postproduction costs incurred in the state of Washington. Additional requirements must be met for certain expenditures to qualify.

Additional Considerations	Loan-out Registration: No To qualify for funding, each project must at minimum meet the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A Washington resident must hold at least one of the following positions: Director, Producer, screenwriter.• 75% of the paid labor force on a production must be Washington residents.• 85% of all production days must take place in Washington State. Productions can receive up to 35% on qualified in-state expenditures for an episodic series with at least six episodes. Documentaries and Reality TV are on a case-by-case basis.
